This includes fostering deep cultural understanding, developing impressive language skills, and initiating important research at the undergraduate, graduate, and faculty level. Recent GSLL accomplishments include:

- Last year, our Russian Flagship Program helped eight students secure national scholarships, and this year another cohort is studying abroad in Kazakhstan.
- Under Dr. Joseph Rockelmann's direction, the German Club hosted a huge Oktoberfest and four of his business German students are up for summer internships.

- Dr. Adi Nester organized a wildly successful <u>undergraduate research</u> <u>symposium</u>.
- Next spring, Professor Stanislav Shvabrin will teach his <u>new course on</u> <u>Ukrainian literature</u> and Professor David Pike will offer his courses on <u>dictators</u> and the <u>cold war</u>.
- Dr. Ruth von Bernuth is a visiting fellow at <u>University of Oxford</u>, as is Dr. Inga Pollmann at <u>Cinepoetics</u>, <u>Berlin's Center for Advanced Film</u> <u>Studies</u>.
- Dr. Gabriel Trop hosted an international conference on posthumanism.
- Faculty hosted a well-attended reception for parents during Family Weekend and met with delegations from Tübingen and Zurich.
- Sadly, we also bid farewell to our esteemed colleague <u>Professor</u> <u>Siegfried Mews</u>.
